Any extra tuition is only provided with the written permission of a parent. The annual fees cover 30 lessons per year, which are split equally across the three terms. In the event that a teacher is unable to provide a lesson in a particular week, every effort will be made to ensure this lesson is caught up, and if it cannot be, the termly charge will be reduced by the number of lessons missed in that term. Please note that if lessons are missed by no fault of the teacher, we cannot guarantee that these lessons will be made up, and under these circumstances, the lessons will still be charged for.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Various co-curricular clubs and activities are offered at College, many of which do not carry any extra cost (for example sports clubs and debating society). Some co-curricular activities, such as horse-riding, tennis coaching and dance lessons, do have an additional cost. Should your daughter be interested in taking part of any of these activities which carry a cost, you will receive full details, including prices for the tuition and transport costs, where applicable.

SUNDRY EXTRAS

Excursions and other sundry extras can be requested by a pupil and can sometimes be a necessary part of the curriculum, for which a charge might be made. Practical subjects such as Food Technology and Art will also incur charges for materials used.

In the case of field trips, PE tours and overseas visits, the College will request permission from the parent and full payment in advance.

EXAMINATION FEES

Please note that all public examinations including IB, A Levels, GCSEs etc. are chargeable and will be added to the school invoice.

CONDITIONS RELATING TO EXTRA TUITION

Please ensure that you contact the relevant Head of Department should you wish to either commence, discontinue or alter existing arrangements regarding extra subjects.

Notice is required in writing to the Head of Department in order to discontinue these extra-curricular activities, and the relevant departments will be in touch with you at the start of the academic year to confirm the termly deadlines for cessation of these lessons. A term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged should insufficient notice be provided.
