

## SIXTH FORM ENTRY IN SEPTEMBER 2026 MUSIC

We welcome applications from candidates applying for A Level Music and IB Music.

The Music entrance examination consists of two parts – a performance and the completion of a 45-minute listening test.

## 1. Performance

- <u>ANY</u> style is welcome we cannot state this strongly enough! We are very open-minded, and would love to receive performances based on improvisation as well as from notated music and welcome the opportunity to be inspired by your music making.
- By the end of your time in 6<sup>th</sup> form, the minimum standard for performance should be Grade VI. You do not need to be at this standard for this entrance process! We are more interested in your ability to communicate expressively than technically demanding works at this stage.
- The work could be solo or accompanied as appropriate.
- You can use a backing track if you wish.
- For non-scholarship applicants, there will be an option to record this remotely and submit as a video.

## 2. Listening Test

The listening test will ask you to write openly about features of a piece of
music that you will be provided with. There will not be specific theory-related
questions, but rather the question set will seek to enable you to write about
significant features of the piece that you notice, in as much detail as you are
able.
